

Discharge to Home WITHOUT Coronavirus (COVID-19) Testing

You were not tested for COVID-19 today because you are not showing symptoms that you are infected.

Symptoms of COVID-19 may include:

- cough
- shortness of breath
- fever
- loss of smell.

The following may be present with these symptoms but are NOT by themselves symptoms of COVID-19:

- muscle aches
- headache
- tiredness or weakness
- runny nose
- chills
- vomiting (throwing up)
- diarrhea (loose stools).

If you develop a new cough, shortness of breath, fever, or loss of smell while at home, call the COVID-19 hotline at 888-312-0847 between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Go to the closest emergency department or call 911 if you:

- have trouble breathing or are so short of breath that you can't speak a sentence without stopping to breathe
- feel so weak that you can't walk to the bathroom or care for yourself
- are confused
- have low blood pressure.

You may give this form to your employer to show that you came to the screening center but testing was not needed.
