

# Approval of President Biden by Partisanship Spring 2021/Spring 2022




# Perceptions of the Economy

(% Responding “Very Good” or “Fairly Good”)




# Perceptions of Tennessee and U.S. Economy by Partisanship

% Responding “Very Good” or “Fairly Good”







Thinking about the criminal justice system in the United States/Tennessee, would you say it needs?














# Preference for Death Penalty v. Life in Prison With No Possibility for Parole by Partisanship

If you could choose between the following two approaches, which do you think is the better punishment for those convicted of murder?





# Support of Taxpayer Funded Rehabilitation Programs for People Convicted of Crimes by Partisanship



















Which comes closest to your view, even if none is exactly right?





There is a lot of discussion about polarization in the country today. There are different reasons offered for polarization. Which of the following do you think is most responsible?








# Would you like to see Joe Biden Run for Re-election For U.S. President in 2024 by Partisanship












# Opinion on funding amounts for public schools by Partisanship – Students with Disabilities

Do you think the amount of funding a school district receives from the state....









Who do you think should make most of the decisions about public education in the state?










