


TITLE IX ANNUAL DATA REPORT

The Title IX Office addresses reports of sexual misconduct and gender discrimination, collaborates on issues of gender equity, and provides pregnancy and parenting accommodations at Vanderbilt. Data about sexual misconduct incidents include all reports made or referred to the Title IX Office. A single report may include allegations of multiple policy violations, and multiple reports may have been submitted about a single alleged incident.
